ELECTRICAL SAFETY BASICS

Replace torn electrical cords. Do not tape or fix them.

Cover all electrical switches, circuit spaces in panel boxes, outlets and other electrical components.

Use tools that are properly grounded. Power tools should have a third ground prong or be labeled double insulated.

Use non-metallic ladders to conduct electrical repairs.

Never lay electrical cords over water unless they are rated as waterproof.

Do not use power tools in wet environments, or if one's hands are sweaty.

Place rubber insulating mats at the base of high voltage boxes.

Do not overload circuits or use multi-plug adapters.
